The Rohr Cleanup Project is addressing environmental impacts from historic operations in accordance with today's regulatory standards at the Rohr facility at 8200 Arlington Avenue in Riverside (Site). The Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board (Santa Ana Water Board) and United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) approved this work as described below.

Why am I receiving this work update?

Environmental sampling conducted to date has identified impacts to soil, soil vapor and groundwater at the Site and adjacent to the Site. The focus of this upcoming work is to address soil containing polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) and hexavalent chromium (Cr6) in the western area of the Site (see map figure on reverse side). You are receiving this work update because you live, work, have a child that attends school, or own/lease property near the Site where work will take place.

What work is being done?

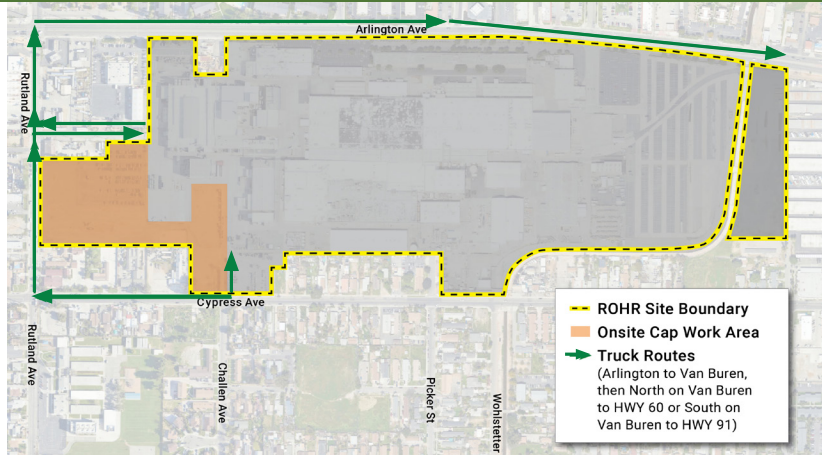
An asphalt cap will be placed over unpaved areas in the western portion of the Site, which is used for employee parking. This work will prevent potential contact with impacted soils and prevent contaminants from leaving the Site. Rohr and its contractors have worked closely with the regulatory agencies and the City of Riverside to obtain permits to conduct this work.

What will I see during this work?

This work will include backhoes, excavators, large drill rigs and big-rig trucks. Community members will see increased truck traffic on adjacent streets and may see and hear crews breaking up and removing on-site concrete slab foundations to support cap construction. Work activities will be completed in compliance with the City of Riverside Working Hours and Noise Control Ordinance. All work will be conducted in accordance with the approved Revised Onsite Soil Remediation Work Plan posted to GeoTracker (see link on back) and includes protection for open excavations, a Site-Specific Health and Safety Plan (HASP), Dust Control and Perimeter Monitoring Plan and Traffic Control and Management Plan.

Work will begin May 4, 2026 and continue through February 2027. Work will be conducted Monday – Friday from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., excluding holidays. Work may include some Saturdays from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m., as needed.
